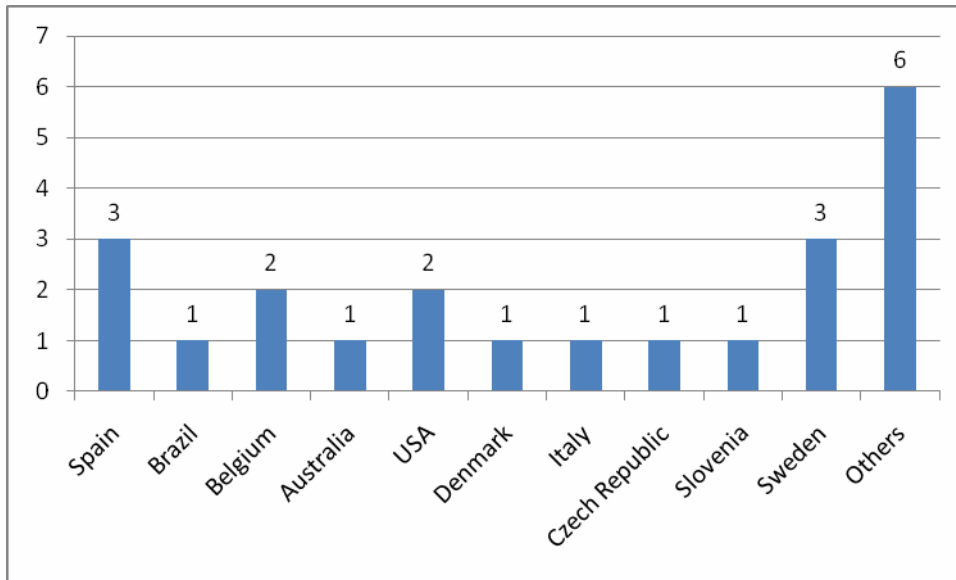


Figure 1: Number of respondents by country (total=22)

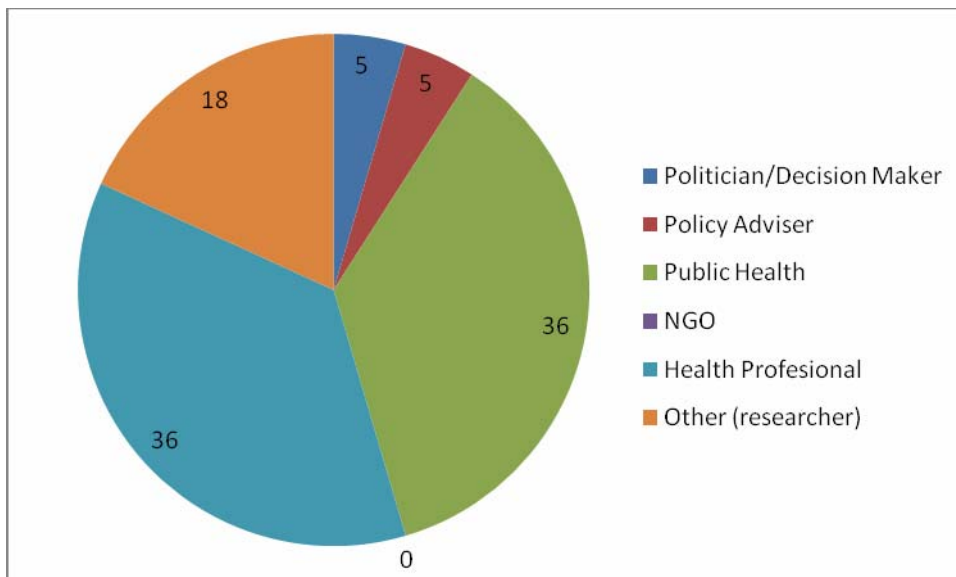


Figure 2: Percentage of respondents by work position

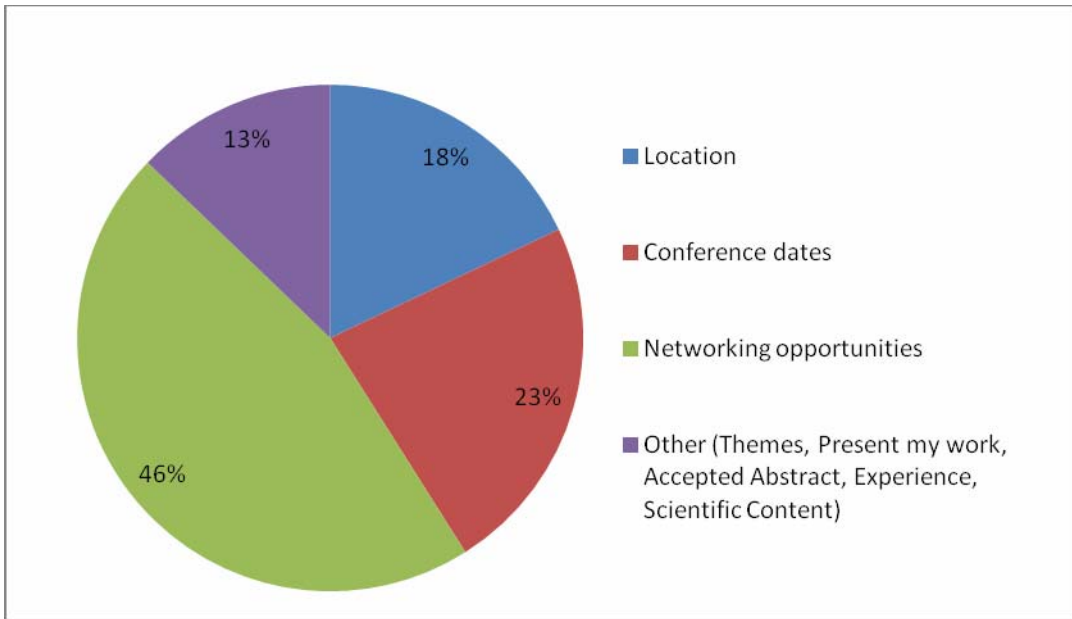


Figure 3: Percentage of most important logistical factors influencing the decision to attend the conference

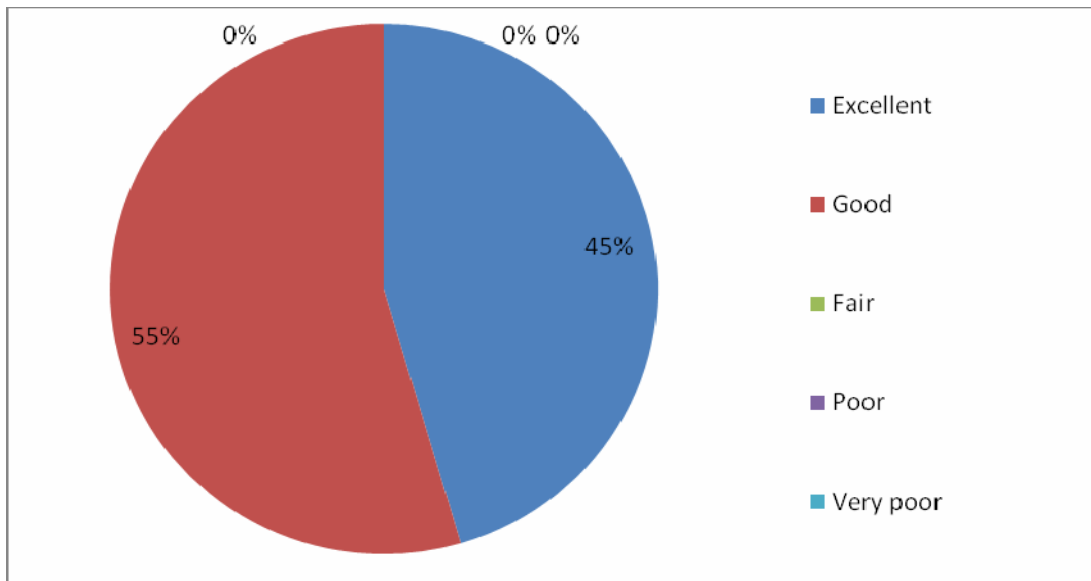


Figure 4: Percentage of overall impression of the conference

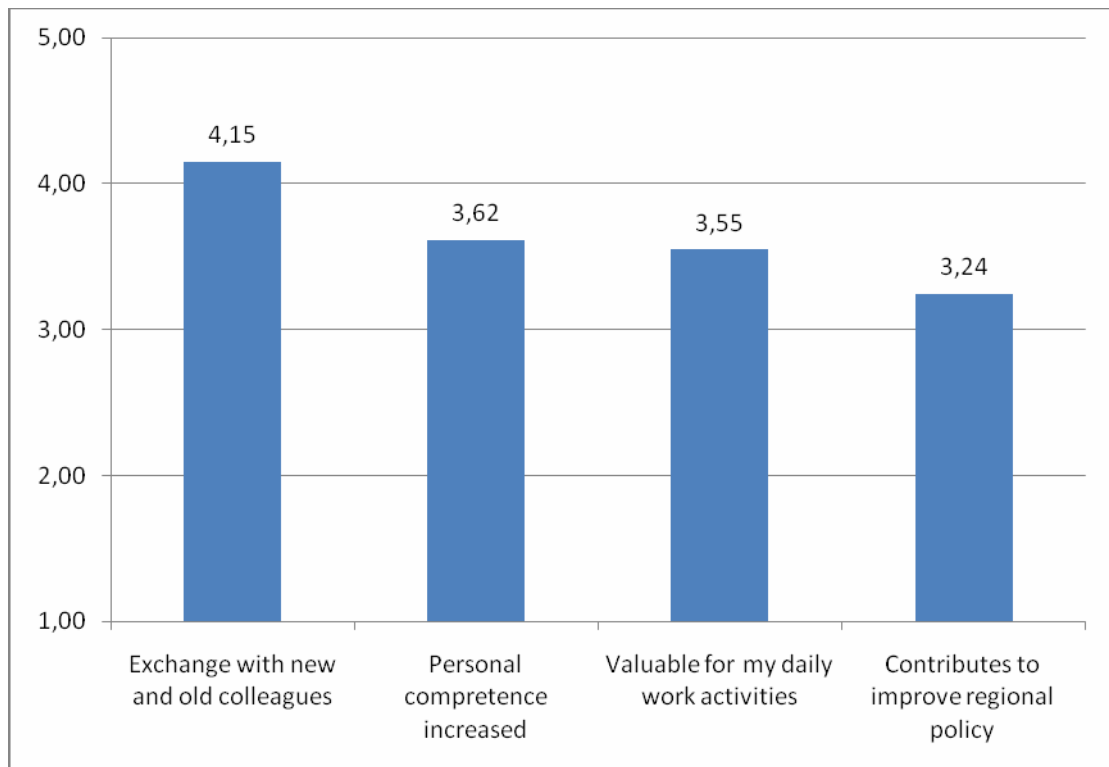


Figure 5: Mean scores of the potential impact of the conference (scores varied from 1=not at all satisfied to 5=strongly satisfied)

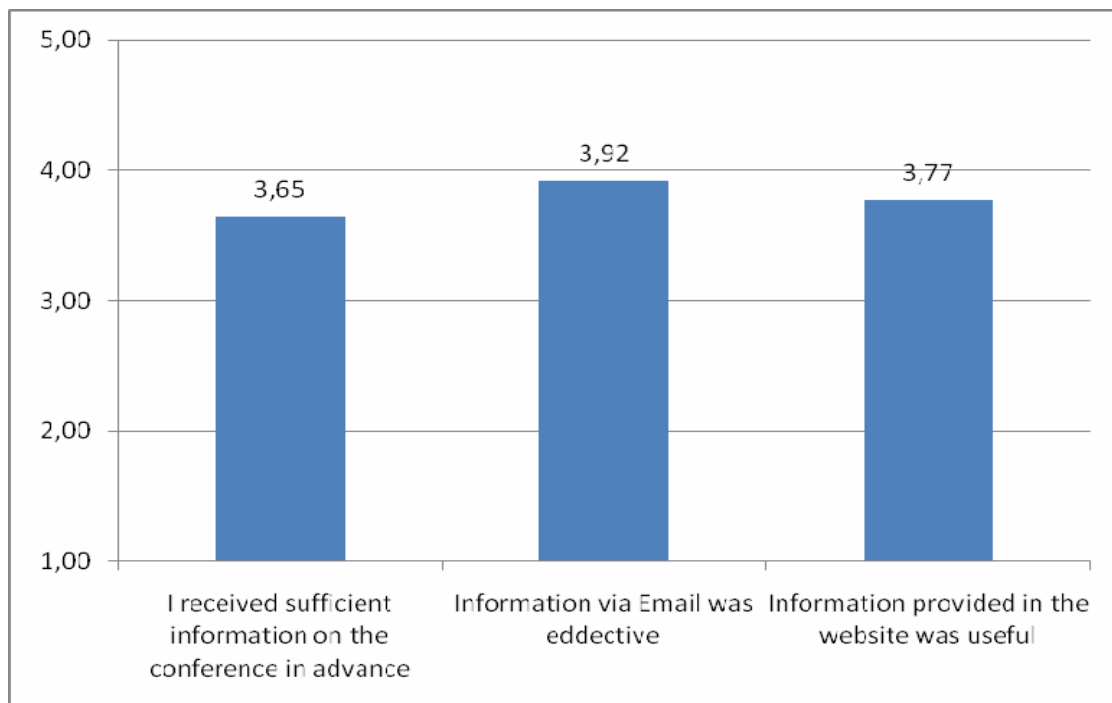


Figure 6: Mean scores of the Pre-Conference Issues (scores varied from 1=not at all satisfied to 5=strongly satisfied)

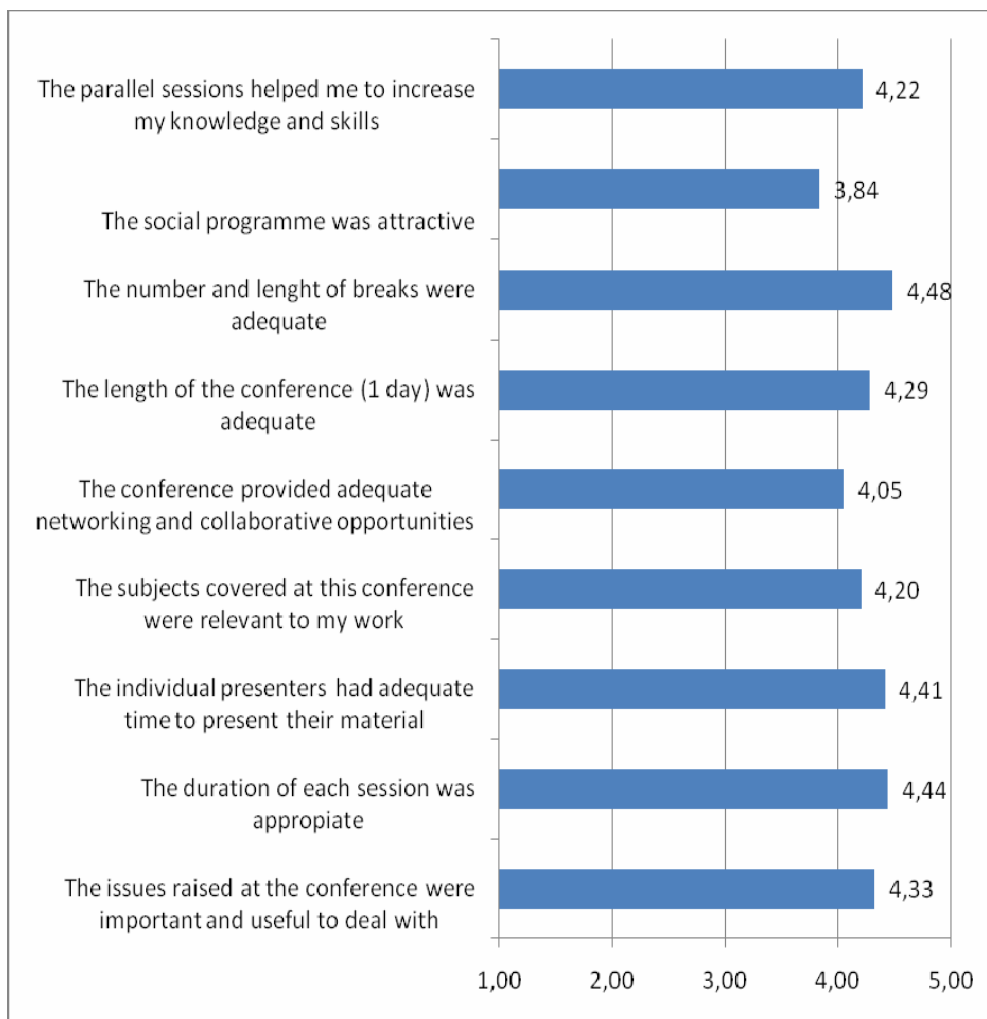


Figure 7: Mean scores of the general conference issues (scores varied from 1=strongly disagree to 5=strongly agree)
