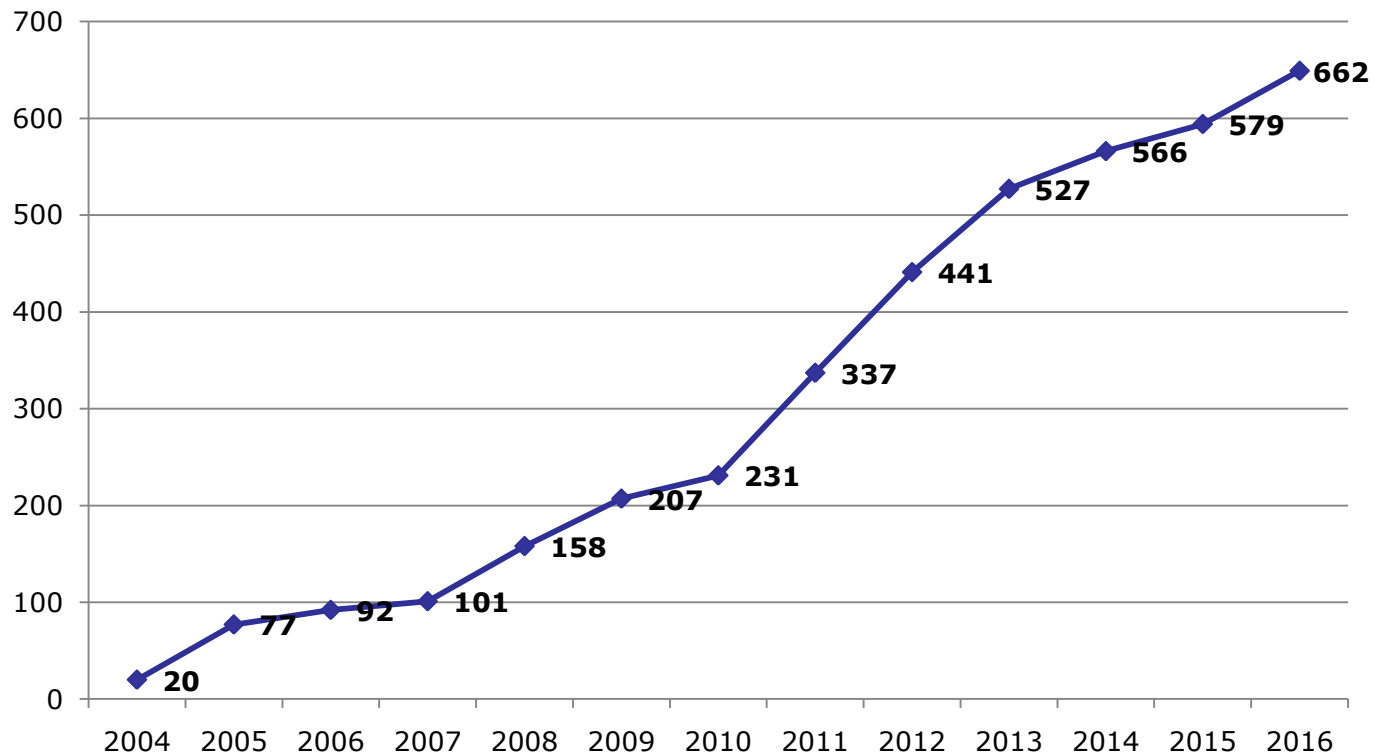

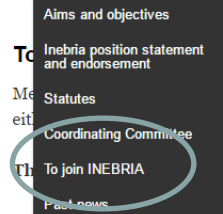
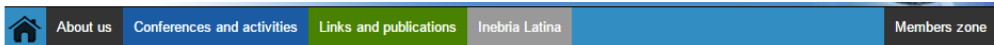


# Registration Inebria

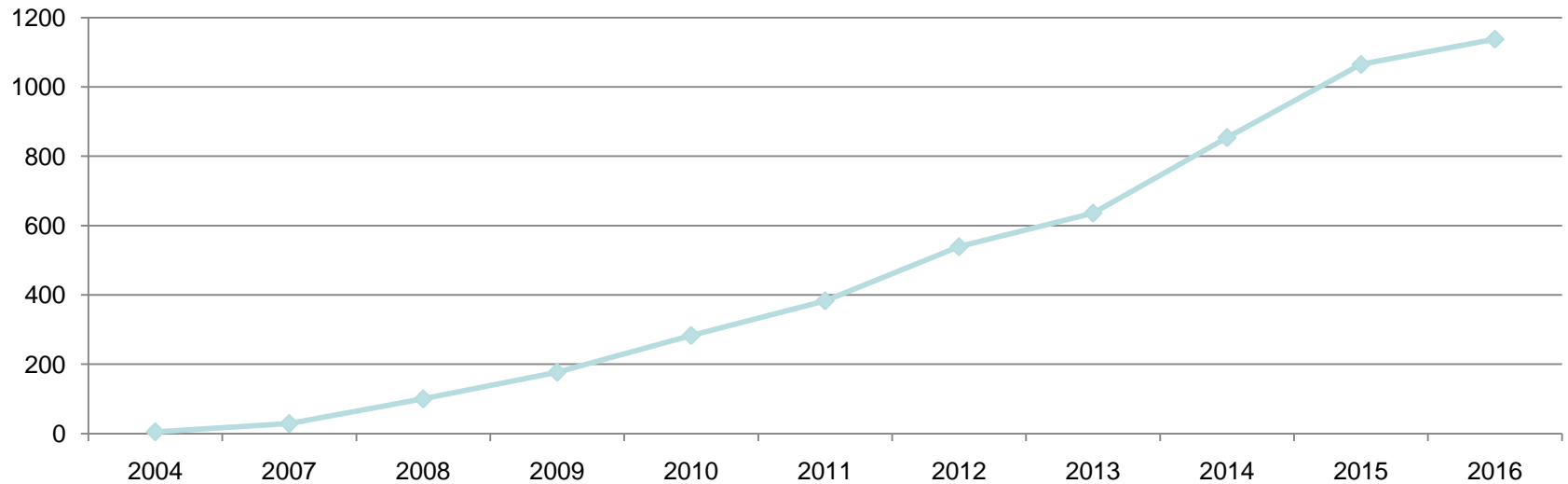

**Articles growth by year**



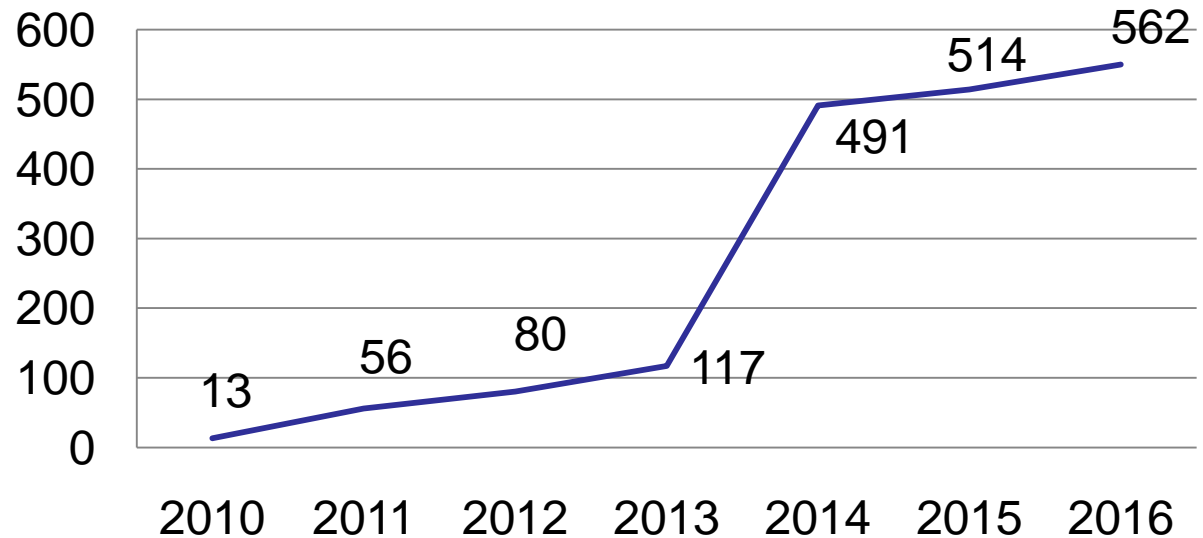

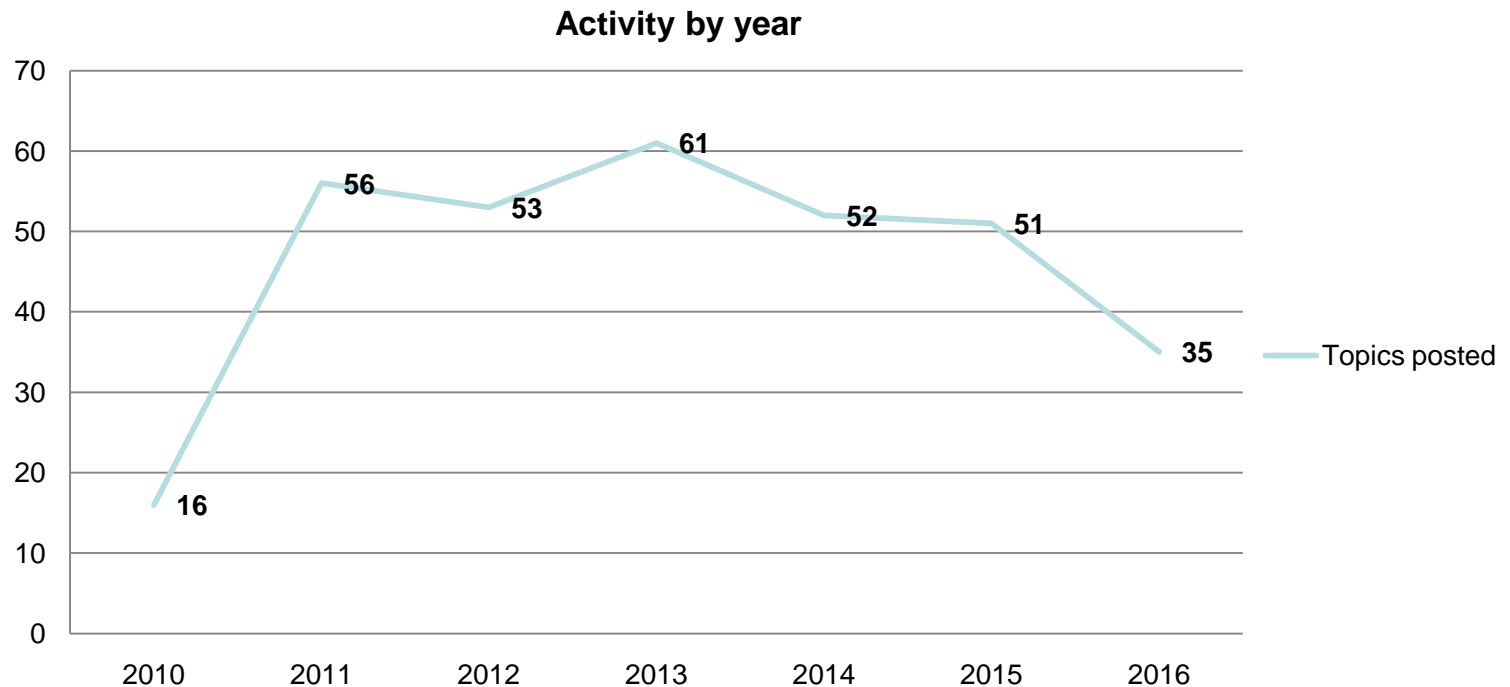
