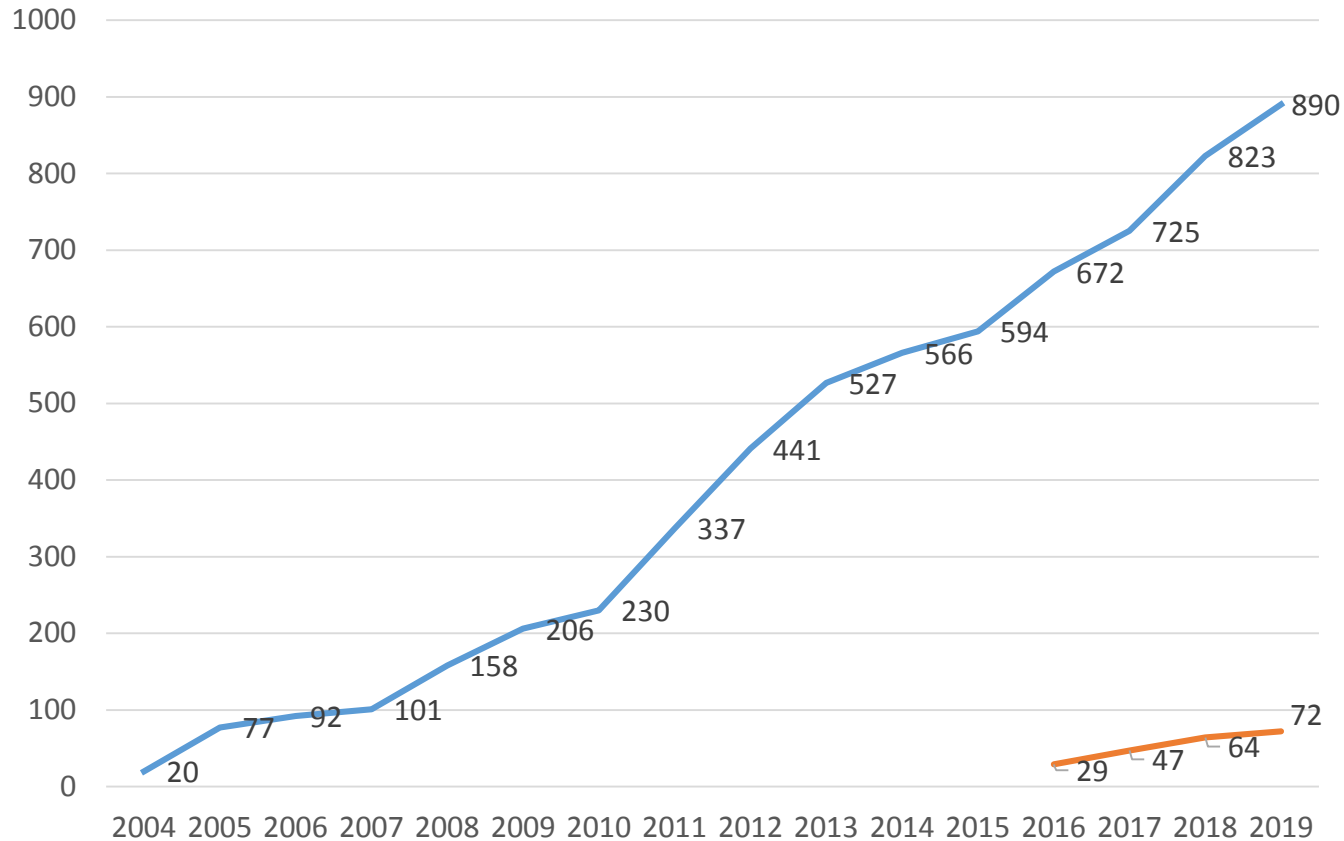


Support to the CC and coordination

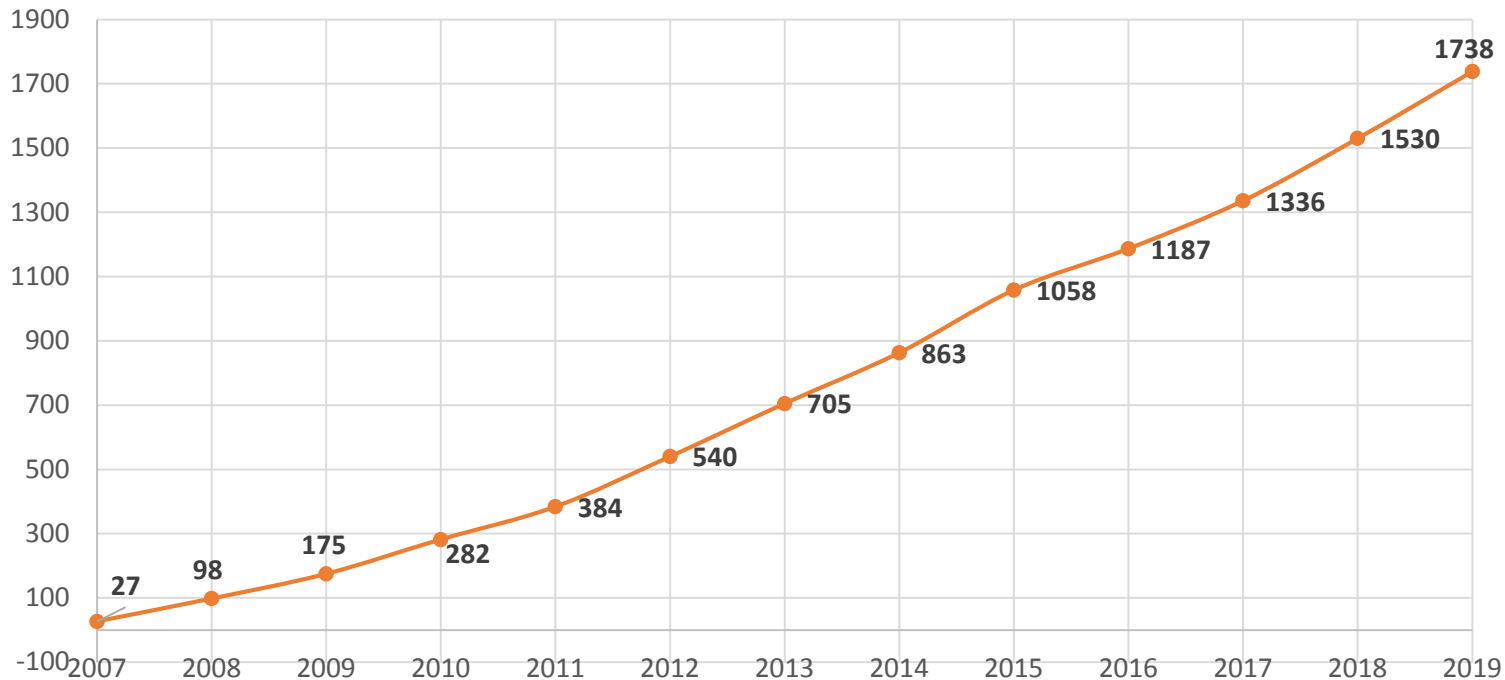

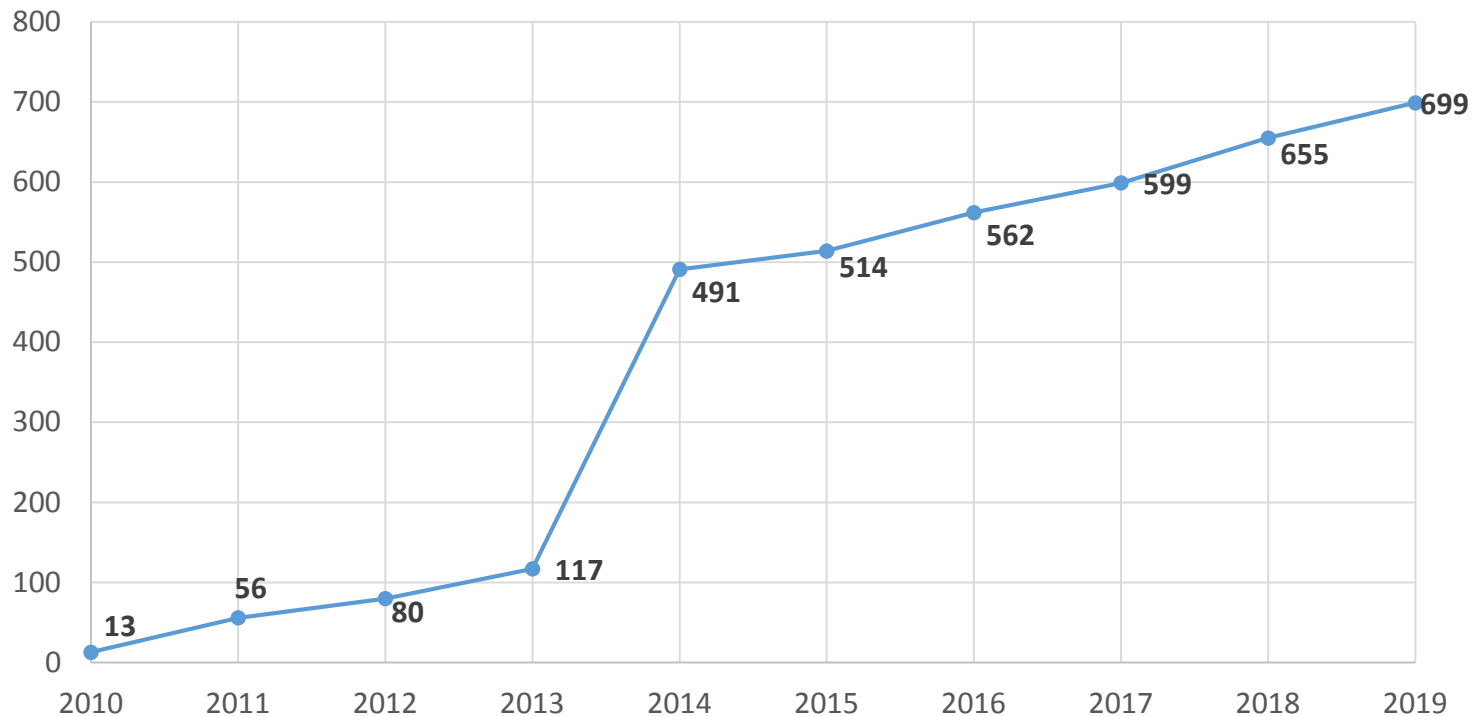


Articles growth by year

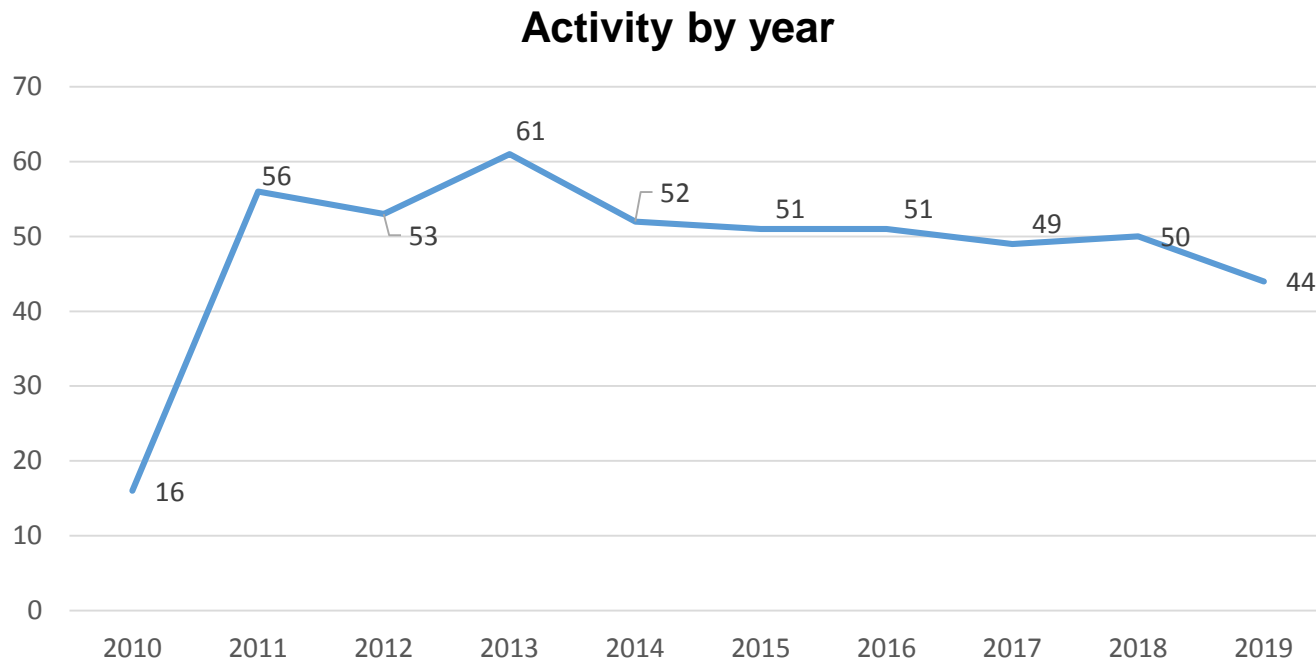

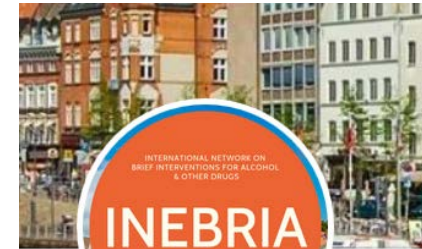

 - **1500\$** (to cover travel costs) + registration fee (**350\$**). Criteria:
 - Resident in countries included in the LMI countries
 - Be an early stage professional working in the SBI field
 - Member of Inebria
 - Accepted abstract for the conference
- Forms reviewed independently by 3 members of the Coordinating Committee: Sven Andreasson, Amy O'Donnell and Lidia Segura.
- Mentoring activities offered

What do we offer?

INEBRIA offers different options of funding to support participation in the Lübeck conference. The options are the following:

1. Waived conference fee
2. Cost of travelling to Lübeck, Germany (up to a limit of \$1,000)
3. Accommodation expenses (up to a limit of \$500)
4. Full support (waived fee, travel, accommodation) (up to a limit of \$1,500 plus fee)

In the application form, you will need to specify the level of funding support required. In addition, awarded candidates will take part in mentoring activities during their participation in the Lübeck Conference. More details will be provided after the selection.

It is vital that you submit all the necessary information, otherwise your application will be not considered.

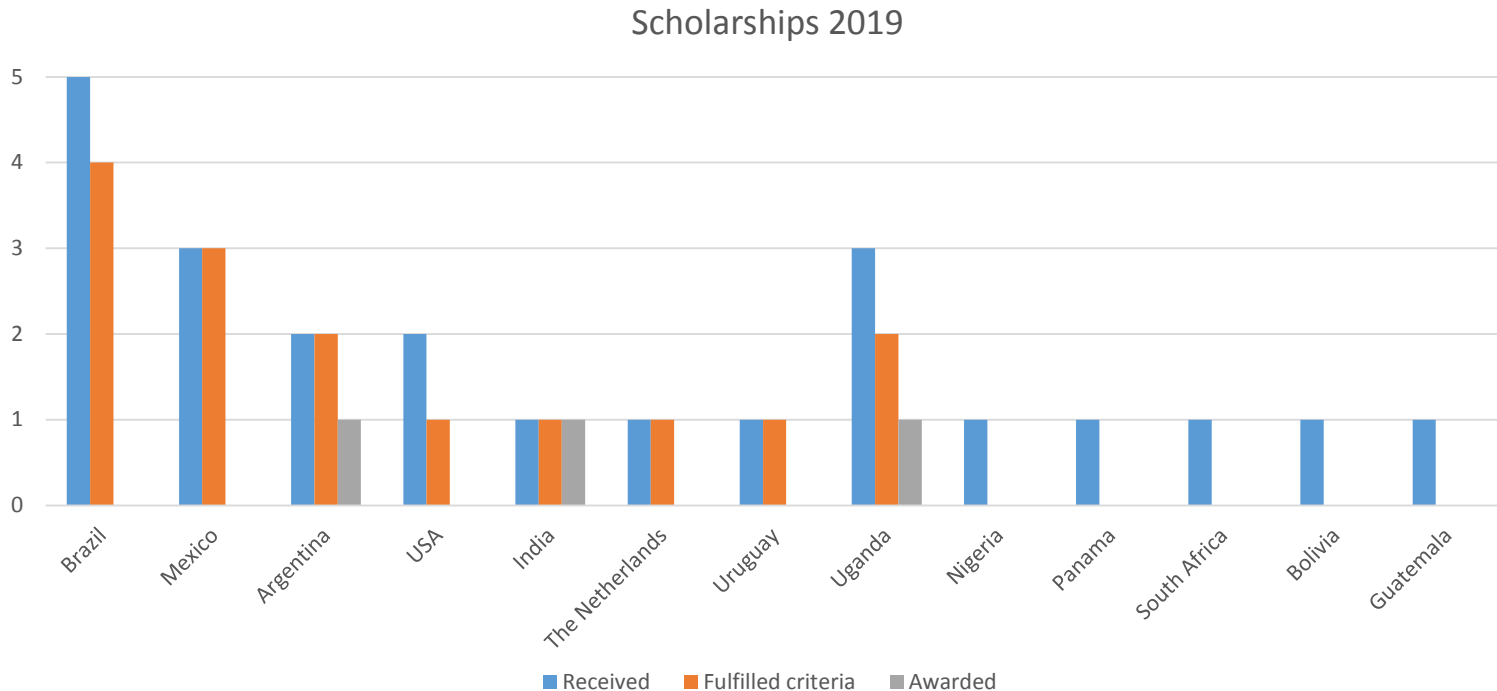
IMPORTANT:

Scholarships 2019

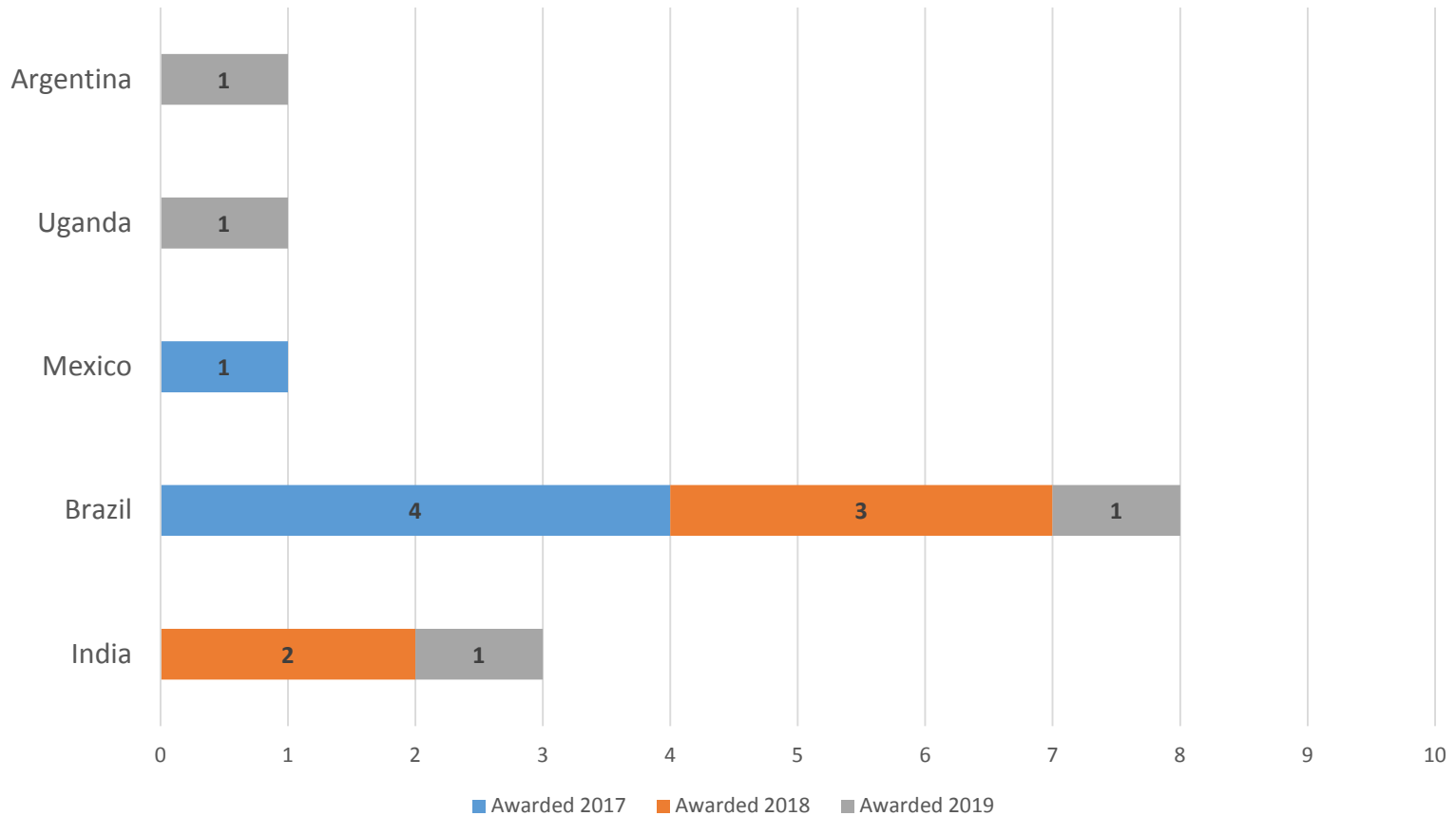
- 23 forms received (from 13 different countries). 15 valid and 8 invalid (not submitted an abstract)
- **Awarded:** Paula Victoria Gimenez (Argentina), Danielle Fernandes (India) and Sylvia Nabirye (Uganda)
 - Camila Chagas (Brazil) was also awarded but refused the scholarship claiming economic support was not sufficient.
